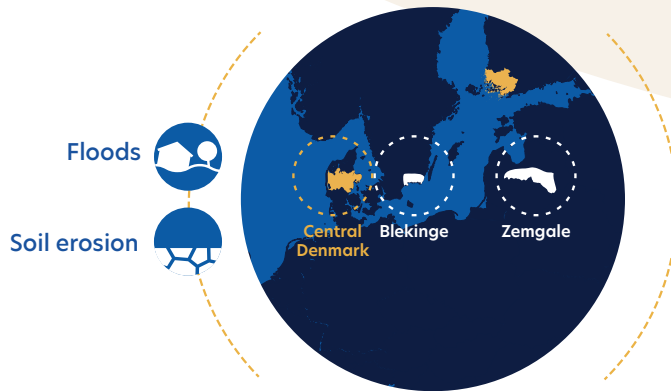

Main focus in RESIST

Blekinge will transfer the know-how and lessons learnt from Central Denmark to tackle shared challenges and develop **innovative tools to create awareness of climate risks among citizens**. The tools are destined to support local authorities and policymakers and will be tested in at least two municipalities in the region.

Blekinge regional partners will also **identify driving mechanisms for accelerating decision-making** and increase the systematic quintuple-helix work on climate change adaptation, particularly relevant regarding the platforms "Climate collaboration Blekinge" and "Regional coastal collaboration".

Goals

- Development of a decision support systems to create awareness of climate risks among citizens and to support local authorities and policymakers in developing and virtually testing climate adaptation solutions.
- Monitoring and data collection.
- Innovative planning documents of all municipalities integrating climate change and to develop a regional impact analysis possible areas of growth.
- Increase awareness among citizens and decision-makers.

Main achievements so far

- **Raising awareness of EU missions amongst politicians and civil servants** through meetings and not least Blekinge hosting the 2nd Forum on the EU Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change.
- **Mapping of expectations, needs and requirements of the Digital Twin (DT)** so that it is used as a decision-making tool in the Blekinge County and definition of DT requirements related to the design of a coastal protection solution for the city of Karlskrona.
