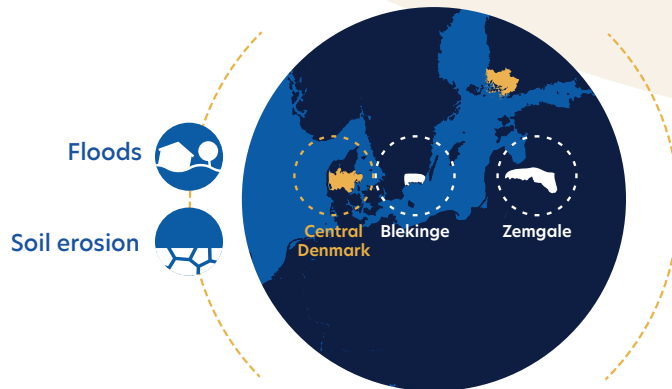

## Main focus in RESIST

Zemgale will work on the **transfer and replicability** of the innovative solutions applied in Central Denmark, in particular the **expertise in data collection, analysis, and data-driven decision-making processes**. Zemgale will thus test the establishment of data collection for climate risks and of analysis and monitoring

systems. Zemgale will apply these in planning practices regionally and locally, **integrating climate change considerations into municipal planning documents**. Support will be given to municipal operational information centres, such as the one existing in Jelgava, which is a flagship for Latvia.

## Goals

- Engage stakeholders, especially municipalities.
- Regional climate risk assessment as a baseline for municipal level adaptation plans and strategies.
- Groundwater level monitoring.
- Increase capacity and skills on adaptation, from CRA to implementation, including on financing .

## Main achievements so far

- **Regional stakeholder meeting with participation of the Climate Ministry**, the private sector and municipal representatives which facilitated networking and exchange on needs so as to embed CCA in the political agenda.
- Preparation of tendering process for acquiring monitoring equipment.
